

Snake Wristband

You will need:

Toilet Paper Tube
Glue (optional)

Paint

Paint brush

Scissors

Wiggly eyes (optional)

1) Choose the color of your snake. Many harmless species of snake are various shades of brown, green, or grey; however, many venomous snakes are brightly colored or have very distinctive markings. Or you can choose whatever color you like and create a new species of your own!

2) Paint the inside and outside of your TP tube. You can paint both areas the same, or make them different colors.

3) Beginning at one opening, cut around the tube in a spiral. This will create a snake that naturally wraps around your wrist.

4) Trim along the edges of your cuts as desired. This should give your snake a nice firm outline. Make your snake thick or thin, however you want. Once you've completed this step, you can touch up any area that the paint didn't cover.

5) Add any details to your snake – patterns, spots, strips, etc.



6) Add eyes. You can paint them on, cut them out of scraps of paper, or glue on wiggly eyes.

Once the snake is dry, you can wear it on your wrist.
